STUDENT PAPER COMPETITION

Each year, ASDSO invites students to enter the Student Paper Competition, open to undergraduate and graduate students pursuing degrees at U.S. universities or colleges.

Topics may include traditional areas of design engineering, structural and geotechnical analysis, hydrology, hydraulics, construction, risk management and hazard mitigation, emergency action planning, dam security, and policy. In addition, case studies, emerging and innovative technologies, and senior capstone projects are encouraged.

WINNING PRIZE

Each winning paper will receive a \$2,000 prize and a travel stipend (up to \$1,000) to attend the Dam Safety conference. Winning papers will also be published in the annual conference proceedings and may be published in the *Journal of Dam Safety*.
