Dam Safety 2026 is organized and managed by the Association of State Dam Safety Officials (ASDSO). Any matters not covered in these Rules and Regulations are subject to the interpretation of ASDSO or their designee, and all exhibitors must abide by their decisions. Exhibitors must comply with the Raleigh Convention Center policies and procedures. The Event Management shall have full power to interpret, amend, and enforce these rules and regulations.

BOOTH RENTAL

The fee for rental of exhibit space is \$1,850 per 10' x 10' booth for ASDSO Members (\$1,600 for Sustaining Members), or \$2,300 for non-members and includes standard pipe and drape, one six-foot draped table and two chairs, identification sign, wastebasket, carpet, one electrical outlet, plus one free registration to the conference and its activities. Your company will also be recognized in the program and during the conference. Additional needs such as computers or added power, decoration, and related services will be charged to the EXHIBITOR as appropriate by the hotel, convention center, or exhibition company. EXHIBITORS will be unable to install exhibits without prior payment of rental fee, which may be paid as late as July 1, 2026, but no later. Exhibitors may not assign, sublet, or apportion to others the whole, or any part of, the space allocated, and may not display goods or services other than those manufactured or regularly distributed by them.

CANCELLATIONS

In the event that EXHIBITOR wishes to cancel some or all of its allotted exhibit space, EXHIBITOR may request and Show Management may grant such cancellation, but only with the following understandings; (i) all cancellations must be requested in writing; (ii) Show Management is not required to refund any portion of rental fees previously paid by EXHIBITOR; (iii) Show Management will charge EXHIBITOR 25% administrative fee if a refund is requested prior to JULY 1, 2026. Cancellations received after July 1, 2026 will not receive a refund. Show Management assumes no responsibility for having included the name of EXHIBITOR in the Exhibition catalog, brochures, news releases, or other materials.

UNOCCUPIED SPACE

If any EXHIBITOR's space remains unoccupied on opening day of the Exhibition, EXHIBITOR shall be deemed to have abandoned such space. Thereafter, Show Management shall have the right to rent such space to any other exhibitor, or use space in any other manner as Show Management deems necessary, in its sole discretion, without any obligation to EXHIBITOR. If no cancellation request has been received, the EXHIBITOR is still held responsible for paying the full amount for the unoccupied space.

LIABILITY

The EXHIBITOR assumes entire responsibility and hereby agrees to protect, indemnify, defend, and save the Association of State Dam Safety Officials, Viad Corporation/Global Experience Specialists, Raleigh Convention Center, the City of Raleigh, and their officers, directors, agents, employees, subcontractors, licensees, elected officials, or invitees harmless against any claims arising out of EXHIBITOR'S occupancy or use of the exhibition premises. ASDSO makes no warranty, expressed or implied, that security measures will avert or prevent occurrences that may result in loss or damage. The EXHIBITOR hereby enters into a covenant not to sue the Association of State Dam Safety Officials, Viad Corporation/Global Experience Specialists, Raleigh Convention Center, the City of Raleigh, and their officers, directors, agents, employees, subcontractors, licensees, elected officials, or invitees for any or all incidents arising out of all claims arising out of EXHIBITOR's occupancy or use of the exhibition premises, in consideration for the opportunity to exhibit at the conference. In addition, EXHIBITOR acknowledges that neither Association of State Dam Safety Officials, Viad Corporation/Global Experience Specialists, Raleigh Convention Center, the City of Raleigh, and their officers, directors, agents, employees, subcontractors, licensees, elected officials, or invitees maintain insurance covering EXHIBITOR's property and that it is the sole responsibility of the EXHIBITOR to obtain such insurance.

INSURANCE

Each exhibitor shall be responsible for securing and maintaining commercial general liability insurance with policy limits of \$1,000,000 for combined single limit coverage to include: comprehensive form, premises/operations, contractual, broad form property damage and products/ completed operations, providing for terms of coverage to be effective from on or before August 29 - September 2, 2026, which shall include exhibitor's move in and move out. Such insurance shall cover any and all damage or injury to any and all persons arising out of such person's attendance at the exhibitor's exhibit during the term of Dam Safety 2026. Each exhibitor must include the following as additionally insured: Association of State Dam Safety Officials, Viad Corporation/Global Experience Specialists, Raleigh Convention Center, the City of Raleigh. Each exhibitor must show proof of insurance prior to installing its booth.

INSTALLATION AND DISMANTLING

It is agreed that it is the duty and responsibility of each EXHIBITOR to install his/her exhibit before the opening of the exhibition, unless previously arranged with ASDSO staff, between 8:00 am and 1:00 pm on August 31, 2026 and to dismantle the exhibit between 1:30 pm and 6:00 p.m. on September 2, 2026. The times and dates may change prior to the event at the sole discretion of ASDSO. Nothing may be posted, tacked, nailed, screwed or otherwise attached to columns, walls, floors, or other parts of the building or furniture. Distribution of promotional gummed stickers or labels is strictly prohibited. Anything in connection therewith necessary or proper for the protection or repair of the building, equipment, or furniture will be at the expense of the EXHIBITOR.

EXHIBIT LABOR

All work involved in the erection, touch-up painting, dismantling, and repair of all exhibits may fall within the guidelines of union jurisdiction and require Union labor to perform such work. This work is to include any use of power or battery operated tools, hammers, ladders, or saws; wall coverings, floor coverings, pipe and drape, painting, hanging of signs and/or decorative materials from the ceiling, placement of all signs, and the erection of platforms used for exhibit purposes.

FREIGHT HANDLING

All work involved in the loading and unloading of all trucks, trailers and common and contract carriers, as well as the handling of empty crates and the operation of material handling equipment, is under union jurisdiction. The union also has the jurisdiction of the unloading, uncrating, unskidding, leveling, painting and assembly of machinery and equipment, as well as the reverse process. Full-time employees of exhibiting companies may 'hand carry' material provided they do not use material handling equipment. When exhibitors do choose to 'hand carry' material, they may not be permitted access to the loading dock/freight door areas. Global Experience Specialists will not be responsible for any material we do not handle.

All exhibitors are expected to comply with any union requirements in effect and as outlined in the "SHOW SITE WORK RULES" section of the Exhibitor kit.

SERVICE CONTRACTOR/DRAYAGE

All exhibit materials should be shipped to Global Experience Specialists, and will be stored by them until delivered to the booths on August 31, 2026. More information on shipping and drayage, as well as additional services and equipment rental forms will be provided in a complete exhibitor's kit by Global Experience Specialists before the conference. All equipment/machinery must be approved in advance by ASDSO and Global Experience Specialists. *Please Note: The Raleigh Convention Center does not have storage facilities for exhibit materials or equipment shipped prior to the Conference, therefore the EXHIBITOR agrees to ship advance materials (if any) to Global Experience Specialists.
